

ORDINANCE NO. 231

An Ordinance amending Municipal Code Chapter 65.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of New market, Iowa, regarding FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of New Market, Iowa;

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 65.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of New Market, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof;


65.02 FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the following designated four-way intersections:


1. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling east on Fourth Street shall stop at A Street.
2. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling west on Fourth Street shall stop at A Street.
3. A Street. Vehicles traveling North on A Street shall stop at Fourth Street.
4. A Street. Vehicles traveling South on A Street shall stop at Fourth Street.
5. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling east on Fourth Street shall stop at Lafayette Street.
6. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling west on Fourth Street shall stop at Lafayette Street.
7. Lafayette Street. Vehicles traveling south on Lafayette Street shall stop at Fourth Street.
8. Lafayette Street. Vehicles traveling north on Lafayette Street shall stop at Fourth Street.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of the ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid unconstitutional.


SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE, The Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
