MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Thursday, July 23, 2020

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the City of New Market will be holding this city council meeting at the Community Center at 512 Main St. Moving the meeting to the Center will allow for social distancing.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Frank Sefrit at 7:00 pm.

Members present included Jim Radke, Chris Stewart, Mike DeVoe, Jacob Cabbage, and Bob Riddle.

It was moved by Jim Radke and seconded by Jacob Cabbage to approve the consent agenda which included the Agenda, Minutes from the June City Council Meeting, Claims for the City, Museum, Fire Department, and Mighty Wash, Financial Reports (Treasurer's Spreadsheet, Income and Expense, Balance Sheet), Allen Building Permit Application, and Reconciliations (General Checking, Fire Dept, Petty Cash, Utility). All members voted in favor, motion carried.

It was moved by Bob Riddle and seconded by Jim Radke to approve Resolution # 2020-14 FY20 Destruction Certificate. All members voted in favor, motion carried.

It was moved by Bob Riddle and seconded by Jacob Cabbage to approve Resolution # 2020-15 FY20 Debt Reporting. All members voted in favor, motion carried.

It was moved by Bob Riddle and seconded by Jim Radke to approve Resolution # 2020-16 FY21 Farmers Mutual Town and County Cigarette Permit # 2021-01. All members voted in favor, motion carried.

It was moved by Bob Riddle and seconded by Chris Stewart to approve accepting High Tech's bid for the Miner Pavilion key card access system if their bid is reasonable. All members choose to neither vote for nor against the motion therefore the motion died.

It was moved by James Radke and seconded by Mike DeVoe to wait until all of the bids were in for the Miner Pavilion key card access system and then make a decision at the next council meeting. All members voted in favor, motion carried.

Bob Riddle made a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Jacob Cabbage. All members voted in favor so the motion carried.
